most of them were read at an international conference held in nice in april 2012 and were substantially revised for publication in this volume all contributions centre around the manner in which british german and american travellers tourists writers thinkers all members of protestant modernizing nations rapidly rising in political and economic power reacted to their physical or merely intellectual encounter with a mediterranean world whose pure light warm sunshine and marvellous scenery could not make them overlook the fact that the glories of the classical past were now set in the midst of a sordid present george eliot in *middlemarch* and that the successors possibly the descendants of the romans in the countries of the south were sunk in poverty religious superstition and racial degeneracy what emerges from these studies that draw on a variety of primary sources is nothing but cruelty decrepitude ignorance and obscurantism with its dark side exposed the mediterranean bears little resemblance to the exquisite lake the fons et origo of form and harmony to which e m forster compared it in a passage to india beyond the portrayal of horrors however all essays attempt to unravel the historical conditions and the nexus of mentalités that determined or inspired the perception imagination or representation of a dark mediterranean and near eastern world not only do they make a useful contribution to the elaboration of the mediterranean as an intellectual construct but their original angle of vision offers a valuable addition to the intellectual and cultural history of the north telling more perhaps about the values prejudices and certainties of northern europeans than about the true nature of the mediterranean south

between 1880 and 1930 some 200 women were murdered by lynch mobs in the american south many more were tarred and feathered burned whipped or raped in this brutal world women defended themselves and challenged male power brokers feimster explores the racial politics of the postbellum south focusing on the volatile issue of sexual violence

wells was a sophisticated fighter whose prose was as though as her intellect walter goodman new york times there is hardly a town in the south which has not an instance of the kind which is well known and hence the assertion is reiterated that nobody in the south believes the old thread bare lie that negro men rape white women hence there is a growing demand among afro americans that the guilt or innocence of parties accused of rape be fully established they know the men of the section of the country who refuse this are not so desirous of punishing rapists as they pretend the utterances of the leading white men show that with them it is not the crime but the class bishop fitzgerald has become apologist for lynchers of the rapists of white women only governor tillman of south carolina in the

month of June standing under the tree in Barnwell S.C. on which eight Afro-Americans were hung last year declared that he would lead a mob to lynch a Negro who raped a white woman so say the pulpits officials and newspapers of the South but when the victim is a colored woman it is different deeply alarmed and appalled by the rising numbers of white on black murders in the South since the beginning of reconstruction and by the unwillingness of local state and federal governments to prosecute those who were responsible Ida Bell Wells Barnett wrote *Southern Horrors* in 1892 a short booklet in which she exposed the horrible reality of lynchings to the rest of the nation and to the world Wells explained through case study how the federal government's failure to intervene allowed Southern states the latitude to slowly but effectively disenfranchise blacks from participating as free men and women in a post-civil war America with the rights and opportunities guaranteed to all Americans by the constitution

the epidemic of lynching that gripped the American South in the decades after the Civil War and the end of slavery has been glossed over and understated in many history books activist Ida B. Wells took it upon herself to document this shameful practice and its prevalence throughout the region and to a lesser extent the entire country in a series of seminal volumes including *Southern Horrors*

Ida B. Wells was an African American woman who achieved national and international fame as a journalist, public speaker, and community activist. This volume collects three pamphlets that constitute her major works during the anti-lynching movement: *Southern Horrors*, *Lynch Law in All Its Phases*, and *A Red Record and Mob Rule in New Orleans*

In the post-civil war American South the despicable act of lynching was commonplace and considered to be a form of vigilantism that was used to murder African Americans for alleged crimes ranging from acting suspiciously to insulting whites. In Wells' 1892 book *Southern Horrors*, *Lynch Law in All Its Phases*, Ida Bell Wells Barnett describes many horrific instances when the law turned a blind eye to the barbaric practice of lynching in an attempt to galvanize the public into action and put a stop to it once and for all. Ida Bell Wells Barnett (1862-1931) was an American educator, investigative journalist, and leading figure of the civil rights movement. Having been born into slavery in Holly Springs, Mississippi, Wells was freed in 1862 during the American Civil War by the emancipation proclamation. From then on she dedicated her life as a free woman to fighting prejudice and violence, founding the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and becoming the most famous African American black person of her time.
